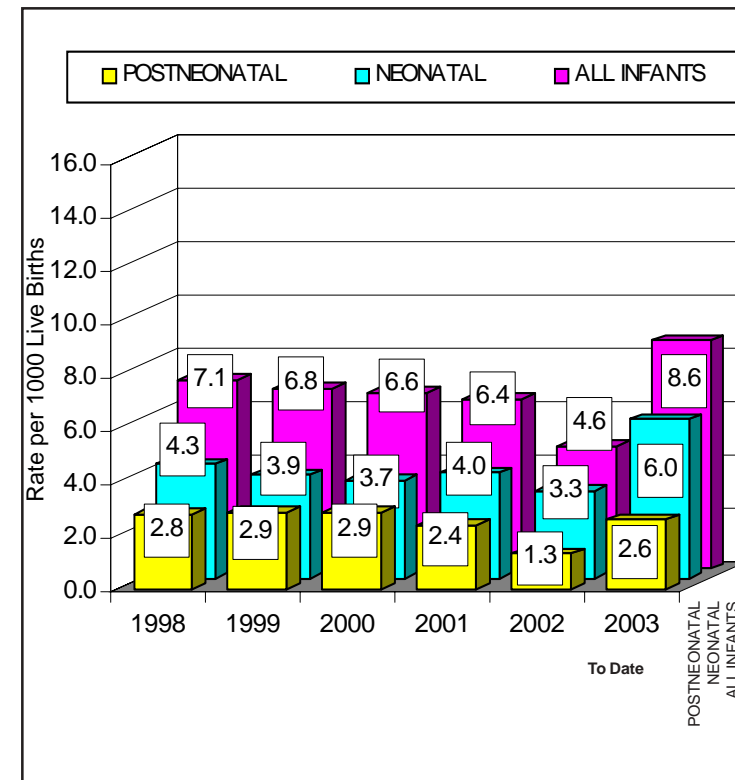

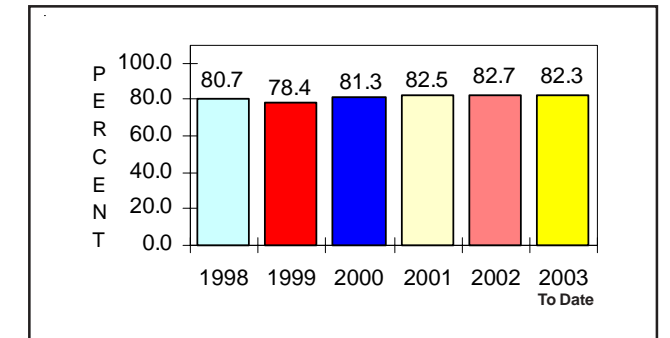

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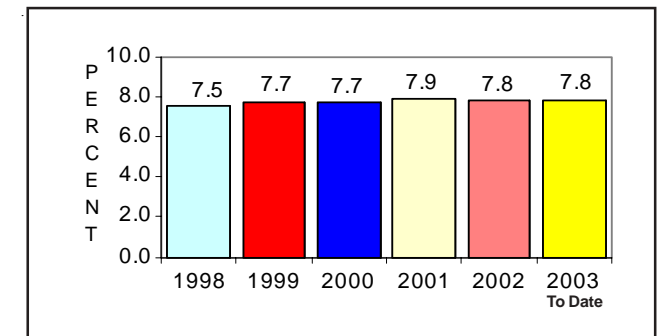
**NEW MEXICO RESIDENT INFANT MORTALITY RATE**

1997-2000 Final Data - 2001-2003 Provisional



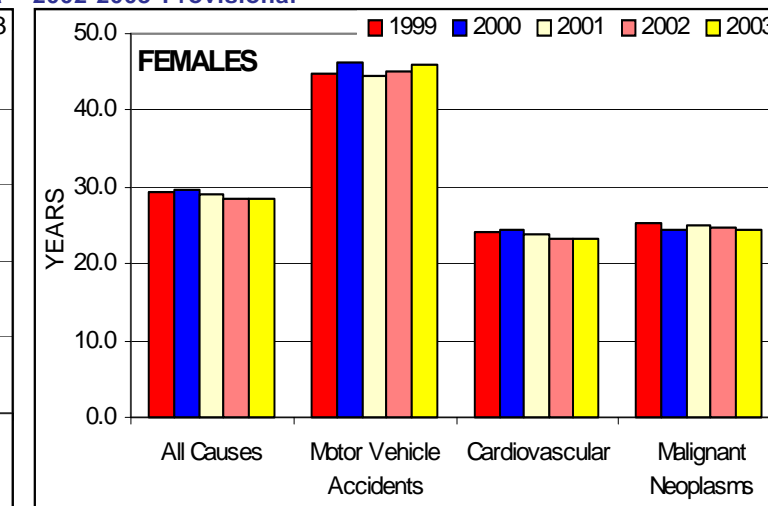
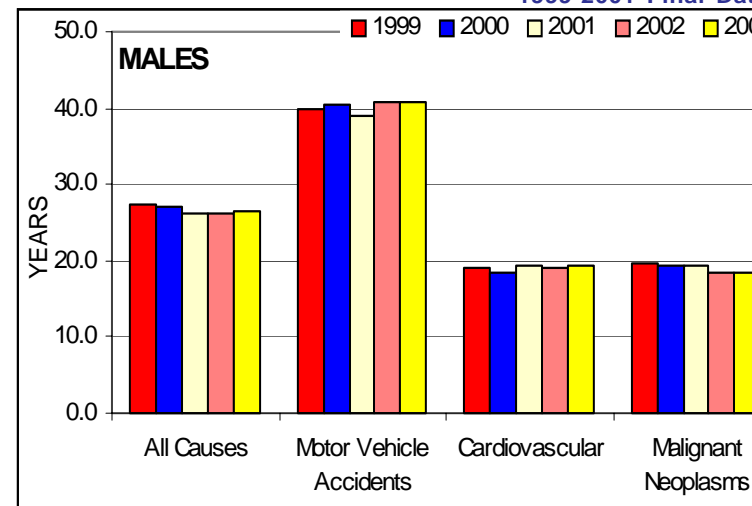
**NEW MEXICO RESIDENT LIVE BIRTHS**

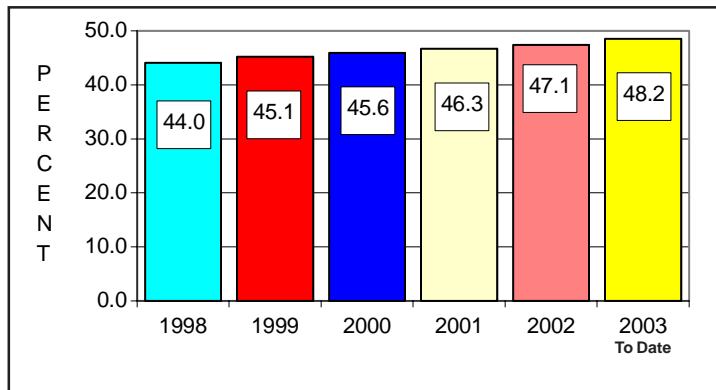

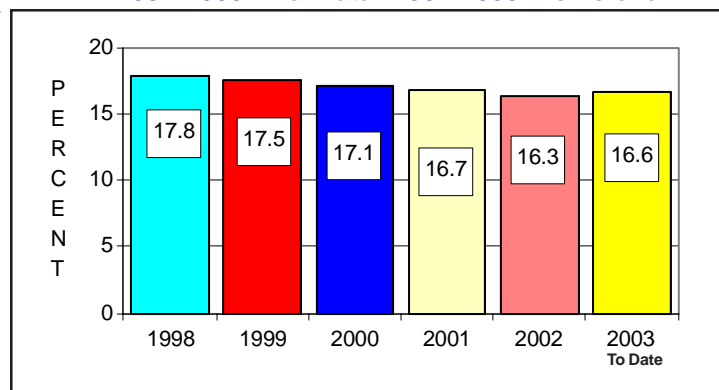
